

STUDENT RIGHT-TO-KNOW RATES DISCLOSURE

In accordance with the Higher Education Act (HEA) of 1965, as amended, the Student Right-to-Know Act, 34 CFR.668 requires that institutions receiving Title IV funding disclose graduation/completion rates for first time, full time students who completed within 150% of the normal time-to-completion. Federal reporting does not include students who have previously attended a higher education institution.

The Student-Right-to-Know rates are published annually by July 1st and based on data reported by First Institute in connection with the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) Survey.
