

STUDENT RIGHT-TO-KNOW RATES DISCLOSURE

In accordance with the Higher Education Act (HEA) of 1965, as amended, the Student Right-to-Know Act, 34 CFR.668 requires that institutions receiving Title IV funding disclose graduation/completion rates for first time, full time students who completed within 150% of the normal time-to-completion. Federal reporting does not include students who have previously attended a higher education institution.

The Student-Right-to-Know rates are published annually by July 1st and based on data reported by First Institute in connection with the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) Survey. PLACEMENT RATES

First Institute calculates and reports placement rates to its accreditor, the Accrediting Council of Continuing Education (ACCET) and the state, Illinois Board of Higher Education (IBHE) on an annual basis.

ACCET Placement Rates

Accreditation placement rates include graduates who completed between **January 1, 2023 and December 30, 2023** and calculated by taking the number of graduates placed in the field divided by the total number of eligible graduates. A graduate is considered a placement upon completion of 30 days of continuous full-time employment in a training related field within 120 days of program completion and verified by the employer and/or graduate.

IBHE Placement Rates

IBHE placement rates include graduates who completed between **July 1, 2022 and June 30, 2023** and calculated by taking the number of graduates placed in the field divided by the total number of eligible graduates. A graduate is considered a placement upon completion of 30 days of continuous full-time employment in a training related field within 120 days of program completion and verified by the employer and/or graduate.
